Last year, the Maryland legislature passed the "Climate Solutions Now Act" that mandated the purchase of all electric school buses after 2024. We believe this was a mistake and that change is needed to recognize propane powered buses as solid alternatives to an all-electric fleet. The Clean Energy Choices Coalition will be setting up a propane powered school bus in front of Lawyer's Mall in Annapolis to showcase the advantages of a propane powered bus fleet. We are encouraging all interested coalition members to show up in support to serve coffee and donuts from the bus to legislators as they make their way to the state house for the start of their daily session. The school bus showcase will be followed by individual meetings with select legislators where coalition partners can speak directly on the benefits of autogas and how this solution was too easily overlooked in Annapolis.
